- ISVAs are Independent Sexual Violence Advisors
- If you are 17 and under you will have a specialist children and family ISVA (ChISVA)
- ISVAs are specially trained to work with victims of recent and non-recent crimes of sexual abuse, assault or rape
- Your ISVA is independent to the police and other services

### WHO WE SUPPORT

- Anyone aged from 0 upwards
- Anyone affected by rape, sexual assault or abuse
- Any gender, religion, sexuality, race
- Dedicated Male support available
- Other agencies
- Other professionals
- We do not support perpetrators of sexual violence

### WHAT TO EXPECT

An ISVA or ChISVA will listen to you and help you understand your choices. An ISVA can provide independent emotional and practical support.

The core role of the ISVA or ChISVA is to make sure you have accurate information to make informed decisions that best fit with your circumstances.

An ISVA or ChISVA will make you aware of what additional support is available to you. We can also help you through the process of reporting to police if you choose to do so
